SCREENPLAY ENTRY GUIDELINES:

REGULAR DEADLINE: November 18, 2011

1. Competition is open to screenplays that abide by the International Family Film Festival (IFFF) Vision Statement:
"IFFF builds a peaceful global family through the discovery and sharing of quality stories by independent artists and production companies."

Any subject matter may be covered within these categories: drama, comedy, animation, musical and sci-fi/fantasy.

2. All screenplay entries must include a completed entry form, the correct entry fee, 2 printed hard copies of the screenplay (**Your name should NOT appear anywhere on the screenplay as it is mandatory that adjudication is conducted without knowledge of the writer's name or identity**), a character description and a 50-word synopsis that has been copied to a

CD. A printed character description and story synopsis should also be bound with the screenplay. Incomplete forms may cause delays.

3. Screenplays that are currently optioned or sold are not eligible for competition.

4. Feature length screenplays must be no longer than 120 pages and short screenplays should be no more than 45 pages. All screenplay entries must be written in English. Any revisions after the entry has been entered are not accepted. Screenplays must be in 11 pt courier font, no promotional materials or illustrations are accepted, pages must be numbered, and be on 3 hole punched paper with brads. No "shooting" or "directors" screenplays will be accepted.

5. It is the responsibility of the screenwriter to insure that their work is protected (US Copyright Office, The Writers Guild of America or Screenwriters Federation of America). International entries should protect their work with similar organizations within their respective country.

6. To have a screenplay returned, please include a SASE (self-addressed stamped envelope), otherwise all screenplays will be destroyed at the conclusion of the IFFF.

7. The IFFF Program Book deadline for Ads is March 5, 2012, and the Spec sheet is available on the IFFF website. Contact: Michelle Eskenazi at 818-390-3540 or meskenazi@iffilmfest.org or info@iffilmfest.org.

SCREENWRITERS SHOWCASE:

The IFFF Screenwriters Showcase will spotlight the Feature and Short screenplay 2 Finalists from all five categories with a "reading" of one scene from each screenplay by professional actors on Sunday, March 25, 2012, at 2:00pm.

All screenwriters shall select a scene from the screenplay and specify the page numbers pertaining to that same scene should their screenplay be selected as a Finalist in a designated IFFF screenplay category for the Screenwriters Showcase.

SCREENPLAY JUDGING:

1. All screenplays are read by industry professionals. All decisions by the IFFF Juries are final.
2. By submitting this entry form and the fee, you agree to abide by the IFFF Jury decisions.
3. The Feature and Short Screenplay Finalists will be listed on the IFFF website by January 9, 2012 or soon after. Website: www.iffilmfest.org.
4. The announcement of the IFFF Feature and Short Screenplay Winners will be made at the IFFF Screenwriters Showcase and Awards Ceremony on March 25, at 2:00pm.
