A HOLLYWOOD FILM FESTIVAL FOR KIDS, BY KIDS

July 19, 2008 9am- 6pm marks the date and time for the 13th annual Freshi Film Festival at Raleigh Studios in Hollywood. Freshi Film Festival is one of the premiere film festivals for young filmmakers in the country. Formerly known as the What IFFF? Kids Film Festival, the Freshi Film Festival showcases films and screenplays from around the world submitted by young filmmakers up to age 18. The submissions go through an extensive jury process, and the films and screenplays selected as finalists are shown throughout the day of the Festival. The afternoon features the Screenwriters Showcase where excerpts of the Finalist screenplays are interpreted by professional actors for the audience followed by a question and answer session with the screenwriters.

The festival also features autograph signings with stars, face-to-face networking with film professionals and hands-on workshops in aspects of filmmaking such as stunts, make-up, animation, voice-over and acting. The festival day ends with an Awards presentation for the winning screenplays and films.

Film and screenplay submissions are accepted through June 10, 2008 and application forms and information can be found on-line at <http://www.freshifilmfest.com>.

A ticket is \$15 per person and includes entrance to all films, the Screenwriters Showcase and all activities. Lunch is provided between 11:30am and 1:00pm for cost of \$10 per person.
